## OVERVIEW:

The essential elements of a Health, Safety & Environmental management system will be presented and discussed with the focus being on adding value through effective risk management and avoiding unnecessary bureaucracy and documentation. Overlap/integration with other systems such as quality will be examined along with lessons learnt from BS EN ISO standards certification.

- Companies with existing quality management systems that want to know what an H, S & E management system would look like along side or integrated with quality.

- To establish the essential elements of a management system and explain their purpose.
- To provide delegates with the clarity and objectivity to design an H, S & E management system that reduces risk, adds value to the business and ensures legal compliance.
- To contrast and compare HSE/EA guidance with BS EN ISO standards to enable delegates to avoid becoming slaves to the clauses of any particular system.

- Delegates will be able to design a management system that fits within their company operations whilst ensuring good risk management and legal compliance
- Organisations that adopt a structured and systematic approach to managing H,S & E will be better placed to take any new or emerging legal requirements in their stride
- Delegates will be able to identify what is really required for effective H,S & E management.
- Delegates will be able to take a fresh look at their own systems and revitalise them in areas where they have become complex and bureaucratic
